# Stakeholder involvement

**Both strategies are developed with wide stakeholder involvement:**

- **Government agencies, Lake Basin Authorities**
- **Non-Governmental Organisations (local, national, international; conservation and development)**
- **Scientists, thematic/geographic experts, consultants, private sector representatives, donor agencies**

# Capacity development

**E.g. CEPF in the Eastern Afromontane hotspot, since October 2012:**

- **50+ organisations granted, 200 individuals engaged through outreach activities**
- **80+ CSOs trained through grants**
- **USD 500,000 capacity building programme being developed**

# Networking

- **Between all stakeholders (e.g. around a KBA, within a corridor/CRAG) – CEPF priority 2.2; MacArthur strategy priority 1.3**
- **Between civil society and corporate sector – CEPF priority 1.3; Mac Arthur strategy priority 2.1;**
- **Between countries e.g. around trans-boundary issues (CEPF: Protected Areas, safeguards; MacArthur: CRAGs, Lakes etc)**

# Networking

- **Between conservation and development sector; NGOs, policy-making, *mainstreaming***
- **Between donors: MacArthur + CEPF: joint calls for proposals since 2013, sharing of information about grants / grant-making**
- **Share information between all MacArthur & CEPF grantees in the region to avoid overlap and promote synergies**
