

### YUS conservation area








### YUS conservation area



- YUS- Yopno,Uruwa & Somrivers
- Traditionally owned by natives
- 2 Provinces
- 4 Districts
- Ridge to reef conservation (4000m-sea level)
- CA act- only PA against extraction





### Tree Kangaroo research in YUS CA



- 1996- Dr. Lisa Dabek did research study on population, status, threats, and ecology of the Matschie's tree (endangered) kangaroo (MTK)
- Since day1, she worked with landowners & all levels of governments
- She identified two main threats as
  - 1) Habitat Destruction
  - 2) Hunting
- In order to conserve MTK, protecting habitat was seen as way forward
- Discussions move into a collection of discrete conservation actions in partnership with landowners of the MTK (TKCP- link people to government)







### Tree Kangaroo research in YUS CA



After years of continued MTK research & collaborations with landowners & government, YUS CA (78000 ha) was gazetted in 2009 as the first & only conservation area in PNG







# Tree Kangaroo Conservation Program-PNG



- Since the beginning of the program, we were working as part of Tree Kangaroo Conservation Program of Woodland Park Zoo, Seattle, Washington.
- The program evolved into a holistic approach rather than just MTK research & conservation
- In 2013, TKCP in PNG was registered as PNG NGO: Tree Kangaroo Conservation Program- PNG Inc






# **Tree Kangaroo Conservation Program-PNG**


