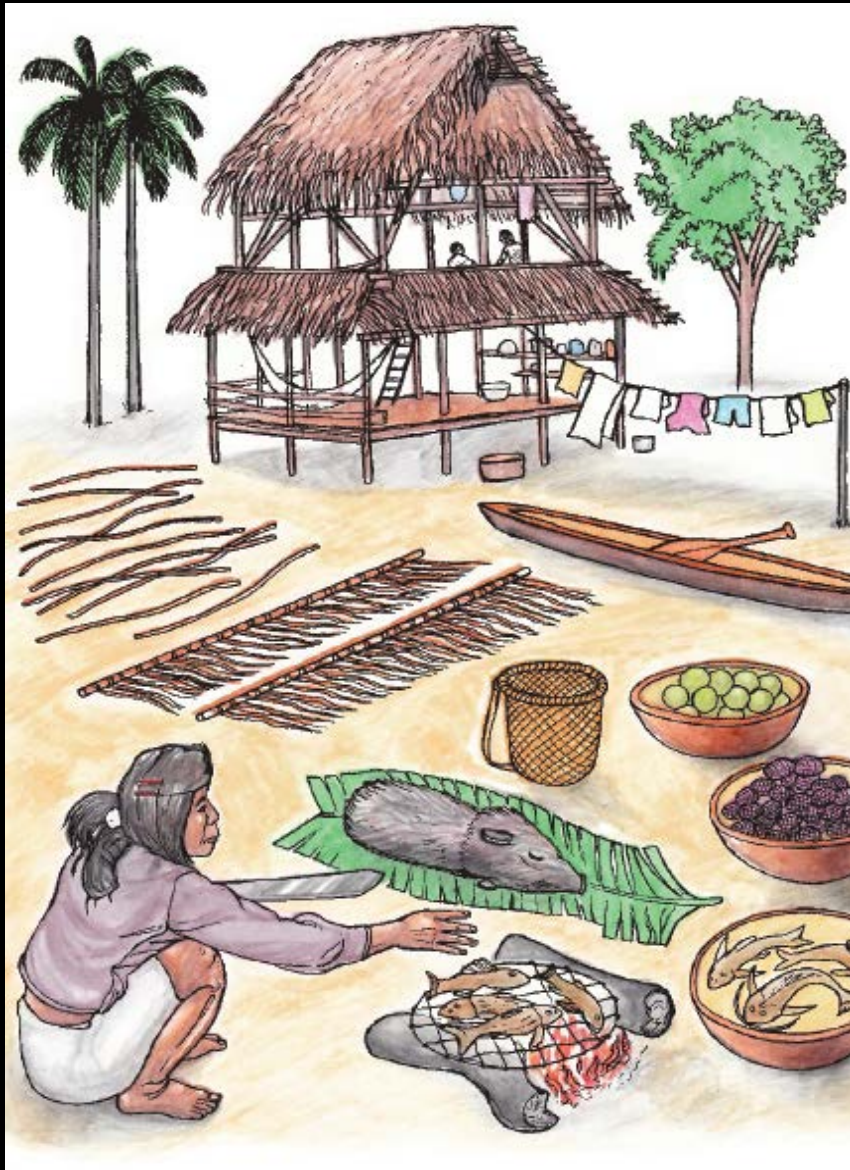

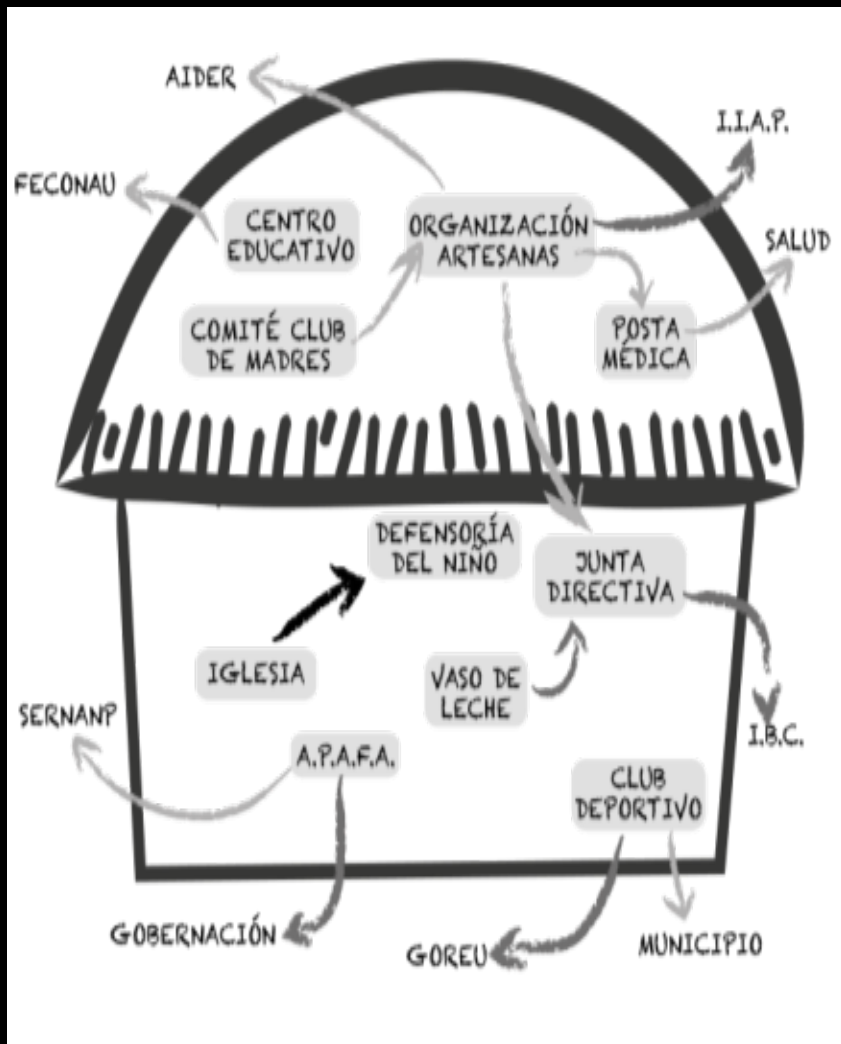


ACR Ampiyacu-Apayacu: Communities' ratings of quality of life

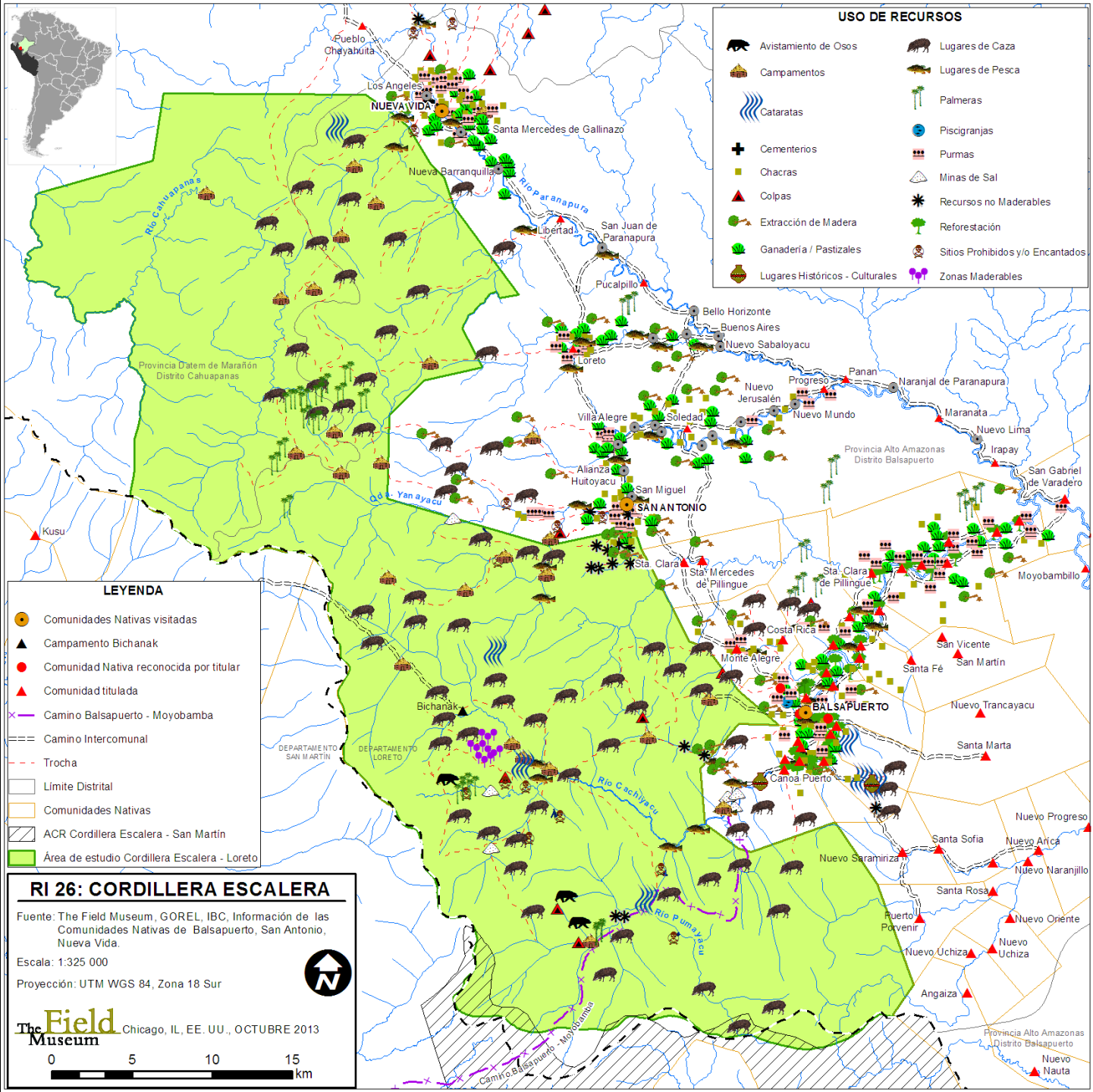
