- Political support for IPBES

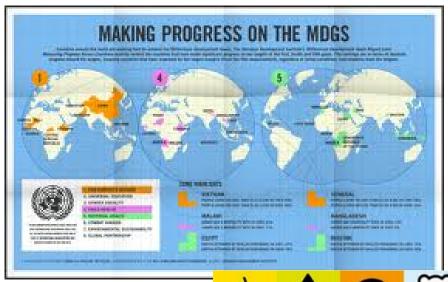






## Sustainable Development Goals as an important opportunity

- Chance to correct the environmental silo (MDG 7)

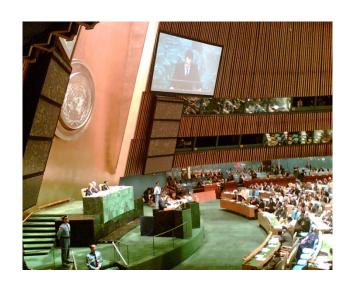

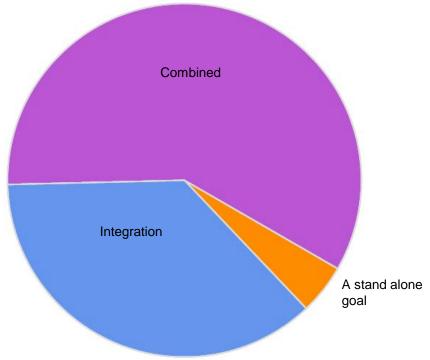

Building on previous commitments - the case of the Aichi Targets





















































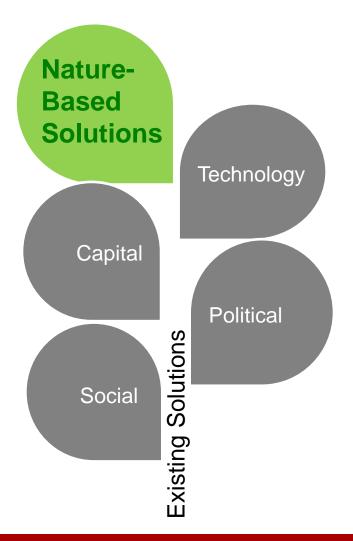

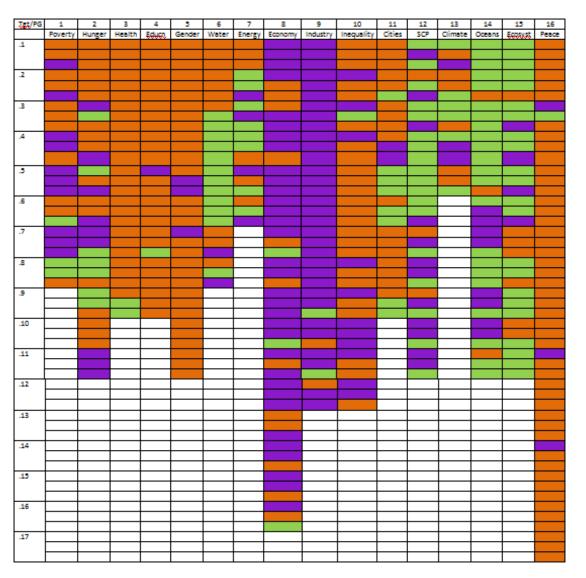

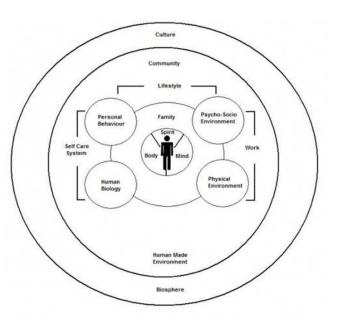


#### **Definition of Health**

Traditional definition:

"The state of being free from illness or injury.

Health is a state of complete physical, mental and social well-being and not merely the absence of disease or infirmity.

### Goal3. Ensure healthy lives and promote well-being for all at all ages

- End maternal, newborns and infant mortality
- Communicable and NC diseases
- Universal health coverage,
   access to medicine train
   health forces
- Prevention of substance abuse - tobacco

- Universal access to sexual and reproductive health
- Reduce deaths and illnesses from hazardous chemicals and air, water, and soil pollution and contamination
- Traffic accidents
- Early warning and risk reduction of health risks
