

Parks, people, planet: inspiring solutions



- 15,6% brazilian population lives in rural areas
- 46,7% of extremely poverty brazilian population lives in rural areas
- 7,5 million of people in rural areas are extremely poors

Municipalities <10% of pop. in ext. pov.

Municipalities from 10 to 20% of pop. in ext. pov.

Municipalities from 20 to 30% of pop. in ext. pov.

Municipalities from 30 to 40% of pop. in ext. pov.

Municipalities from 40 to 50% of pop. in ext. pov.

Municipalities > 50% of pop. in ext. pov.







- Sustainable Use Protected Areas (45 / 73)

- Traditional Territories/ICCAs (30 /87)


