Project objectives






- Strategic positioning of CONANP in the National Agenda
 - Achieve the prioritization of PA as a backbone of national development policies at all levels of decision making in Mexico
- Incorporate the ecosystem services approach into environmental impact assessment evaluations
- Strengthen the environmental economics axis of CONANP's 2040 strategy
- Integrate a bottom-up approach that benefits local people and involves PA's staff into the decision-making process
 - Contribute to the achievement of Aichi Targets 1, 2, 11, 14 and 20
 - Develop and implement a diversified long-term valuation strategy for the conservation, management and sustainable use of PA
- Contribute to reduce the current financial gap of Mexican Protected Areas' operation

Financial Gap for 2012

- 2012 Financial gap: US\$59 million.
- Every year the budget has decreased in real terms.
- The surface under protection is increasing.
- CONANP has not the attribution of collecting nor receiving financial resources by its own.
 - National NGO provide support for administration of non-government funding












CONANP's expenditure 2005-2013



Financial sustainability components

















Key elements for success
