


## **Deforestation in the Amazon**

(1988 - 2013)



#### Deforestation x GDP




### **Emissions reductions**



79 % reduction of deforestation = 3.3 Gt CO<sub>2</sub> emissions avoided to the atmosphere















#### **Next Steps**

- Expansion of CAR registry implementation and simplification of regulatory requirements
- Regular and frequent monitoring of selected areas that represent key land uses
- Funding mechanisms for regional consortia ("green municipalities") for transition to low-deforestation, high production land use systems.
- Development of incentives and tools for management of vast territories with mosaics of different types of protected areas and indigenous lands
