Why GEF interested in Coastal Fisheries?

- Most of ocean's biodiversity is concentrated in near-shore waters;
- Overfishing is among the greatest threats to oceans' health;
- Small scale fisheries account for approximately 50% of the total fish catch volume;
- In developing countries, about 100 million of workers are directly dependent on commercial capture fisheries value chains for their livelihoods;
